



Celebrate the 100th Year Anniversary of the Artillery Barracks, Fremantle

Celebrate the centenary of the historic Artillery Barracks on Burt Street, Fremantle with an exciting family weekend.

The building is a Fremantle landmark and has served as a military hospital and internment camp during World War One, as well as an important base of work and accommodation for home defence during World War Two.

Since 1995 it has been home to the Army Museum of Western Australia, and houses an extensive collection of both wartime and peacetime objects.

The family weekend will include displays of vintage military vehicles and artillery pieces, historical reenactment groups and a stirring performance by the Army Band and Pipes and Drums Perth on Sunday 5th, including the 1812 overture.
